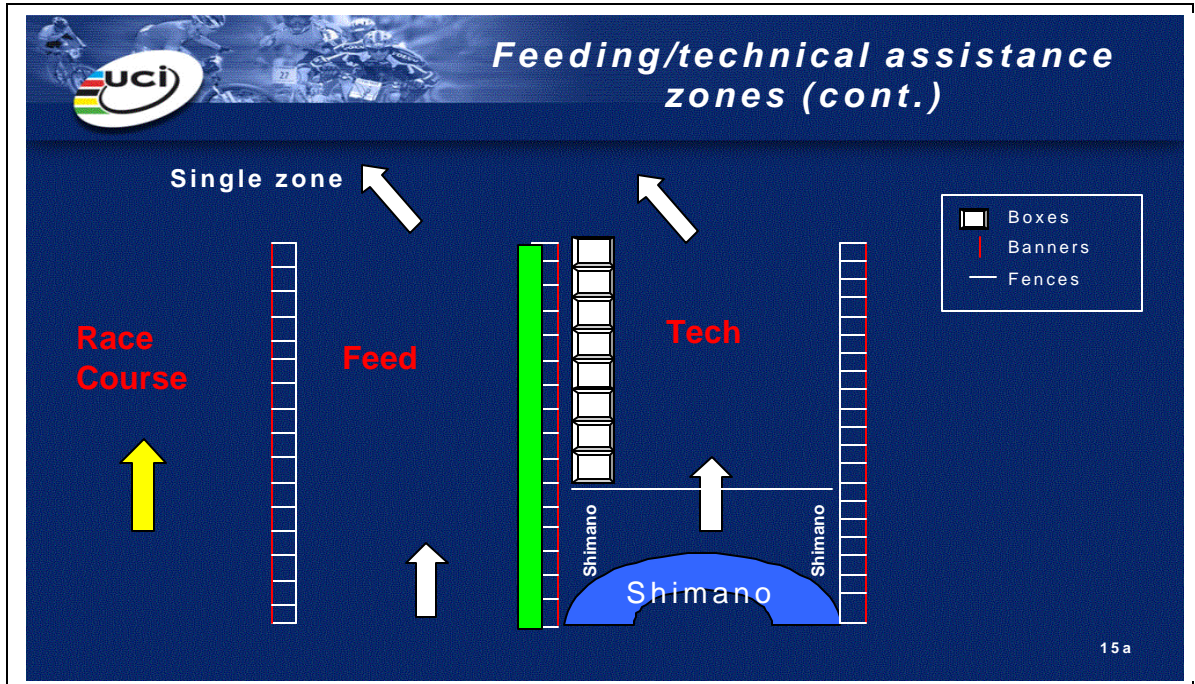


## 2007 Tech / Feed Zone Set-up for Greenbrier Challenge Single TFZ Style



### Greenbrier Challenge - Tech Zone 1

Will be at the end of the grassy area after the start, approximately 200yards on the right side of the course and marked accordingly

### Greenbrier Challenge - Tech Zone 2

Will be in a "series" configuration along the ridge trail at about 2.9Km from the finish of the course. It is accessed by mechanics from a road that leads out of the top of the campground area.

- Riders NOT using the TFZ will be riding on the outside of the zone, to the left of the left red banner area following the yellow arrow. This should be the shortest route.
- The left-most lane of the TFZ (labeled Feed) is the only area where racers can take on food and water. Feeding will be permitted only from the right side of the lane (indicated by the green bar).
- All technical assistance is provided in the right-most lane of the TFZ, labeled Tech.

- After the (optional) neutral tech support you see white “boxes” on the left side of the tech area. This is where you will designate first the trade team area and then the individual area. By demarcating individual “boxes” you cut down on congestion and overlap—think of a NASCAR race and its designated pit areas.
- All tech assistance will come from the left. This makes it easier to control eventual passing of items from the spectator area.
- The banner between the feed and the tech assistance areas will be easily negotiated by a feeder who has to do double-duty as a mechanic, there will be a demarcation between the two areas.
- Each team is allotted one feeder and one mechanic for each zone for every 1-4 riders.
- credentials for the TFZ will be handed out. Nobody without a credential will be allowed in these TFZ's.
